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At 6:37 PM, Mr. Purcell IV spoke for approximately three minutes discussing his service to the Council and his reasons for seeking the Interim Mayor position.

At the conclusion of Mr. Purcell's speech, Mrs. Thompson stood to ask questions of the candidates. She first asked Mr. Purcell to clarify his reasons for wanting to be an Interim Mayor and the reason he would want to resign from his Council seat. Mr. Purcell repeated that he had recently purchased a home out of town, but that the home required remodeling before he could move into it. The remodeling would take several months, and it could be December or a little later before he could move into the home. If he resigned now and became the Interim Mayor, the Town would still have time to do a special election to fill his vacant seat.

Mrs. Thompson also asked Mr. Kersey questions regarding any possible conflicts with him being on the Louisa County Planning Commission. Mr. Kersey responded by saying that he did not foresee any conflicts and that as Mayor he would always put the Town first.

Mr. Rick Meyer stood to discussed issues of importance to the Tanyard neighborhood and stated that he plans to work in a positive way with the candidates.

Council member Crawford spoke to let people know that the Council members do get along with each other and respect each other, but they do not always agree. He made this statement in reference to a perception in the community that the Council members are at odds with each other.

Council member Henry spoke to each candidate about the importance of being able to negotiate and work with Louisa County and other entities.

Acting Mayor Harte closed the public hearing at 6:59 PM.
