Public Works Maintenance I Worker

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Operates the following equipment: TV inspection camera to inspect water and sewer lines, air compressor/jackhammer, operates non-CDL licensed truck to deliver materials, supplies, and tools
- Removes snow and applies salt to sidewalks and parking spaces on Main Street
- Operates powered tools such as quickie-saw, jackhammer, valve operator, smoke machine, ventilation fan, tapping machine, lawn mowers, and weed eaters
- Performs manual labor in maintenance and construction of water and sewer lines
- Flags traffic as required
- Performs related tasks as required

Knowledge and Skill Requirements:

- Some knowledge of the principles and practices of water distribution and sewer collection systems
- Knowledge of traffic laws and regulations governing equipment operations
- Basic knowledge of the occupational hazards involved and safety precautions necessary in the proper operation of varied construction equipment, maintenance equipment, and work sites
- Ability to understand verbal and written directions
- Mechanical aptitude with the ability to make minor repairs and adjustments to equipment.
- Basic knowledge in the use of computers

Working Conditions:

This is physical work requiring the exertion of up to 25 pounds of force frequently to move and load objects and some heavy work requiring exertion of up to 75 pounds of force occasionally. Work requires frequent bending, squatting, kneeling, climbing, and reaching above shoulders. Work is regularly performed in tight confines. Work requires frequent repetitive tasks using gross and fine motor skills of hands and feet (such as operating clutch, levers, and knobs). In addition, work is subject to adverse environmental conditions including extreme cold, extreme heat, noise, vibrations, hazards, etc.

Education and Training Requirements:

- Must hold a valid state department issued Driver's License
- Any combination of education, experience, and training equivalent to completion of high school
- Experience in the operation and maintenance of motorized equipment
